This scholarship was established with contributions from his family and friends who wish to honor his memory.

The scholarship recipient is expected to attend the World Food Prize Borlaug Symposium in Des Moines in October. There is no registration fee for the scholar's participation.

Also include your career and educational goals, recognized achievements, such as awards, honors, and scholarships, and community, student club, and service activities. These information also may appear in your resume or your statement of interest document. **Do not mail the statement of interest document. Please include it with your resume in the application packet.**
